

ENVIRONMENTAL COMMANDMENTS

Small actions you can do at your school, home or neighbourhood to fight climate change.



1. Turn off lights and electronic equipment when not in use. Take advantage of daylight.



2. Compost and return your food waste to the soil. Turn your waste into organic matter instead of dumping in landfill.



3. Set up recycling at your school. Produce less waste and put the right things in the right bins.



4. Use public transport or join a pedi bus/bike bus group. Organise groups to go to school on foot or by bike accompanied by an adult.



5. Use recycled materials. Get a reusable lunch box and water bottle.



6. The Three R's: "Reduce, Reuse and Recycle". Minimise waste by saving water, printing double sided, etc.



7. Use energy-saving light bulbs, refillable ink and toner cartridges, perishable material with FSC/PEFC labels, etc.



8. School gardens, insect hotels... Actions to acquire positive values towards the environment and beneficial use.



9. Give used books new life. Swap books or donate to your school library.



10. Eliminate single use-plastics (plastic bags, balloons, plates, cups...)
